Learning Objectives/Opportunities

- Basic and Advanced life support measures
- Management of transfusions and infusions
- Participating/observing in deteriorating patients and surgical emergencies
- Participating/observing in health education and advanced communication skills
- Wound care
- Management of Chest drains (ICC) , Nasogastric tube (NGT), Indwelling Catheter (IDC), and other drains
- Pre- and post-operative care management.
- Scrubbing, donning gowning & gloving
- An airway management

Pre- reading/revisiting

Preoperative preparation and postoperative management, understanding a comprehensive assessment and prioritisation of complex care would be recommended prior to commencement of clinical placement. Recapping on Anatomy and Physiology would be beneficial prior to this placement.
