Referral through legal representation, service providers, family members or self-referral. Once approved by the Court, a Murri Court Entry interview is conducted with the Court Coordinator and one or two Elders or Respected Persons. This process links the client to support services to help them make changes in their lives and stop offending. The Murri Court program usually runs for up to three months however this timeframe can be extended as fits the clients' needs. Clients need to be 18+ years of age, identify as Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander and/or Australian South Sea Islander, and be pleading guilty to the charges being brought to them.


