Placement Details

4FW is an acute medical inpatient unit with a primary focus on general medical patients. The unit receives short to long stay patients via the Emergency Department and Medical Assessment and Planning Unit (MAPU).

There will be a variety of conditions and disease processes on 4FW, for example:

- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Pleural Effusion
- Community Acquired Pneumonia
- Upper and Lower Respiratory tract infections
- Urinary Tract Infections (Urosepsis)
- Diabetes
- Cardiac & Fluid Overload, Congestive Cardiac Failure (CCF), Angina, Hypertension (HTN)
- Cellulitis
- General infections
- Infected wounds

- Management of transfusions (Blood) and infusions (Iron and Insulin)
